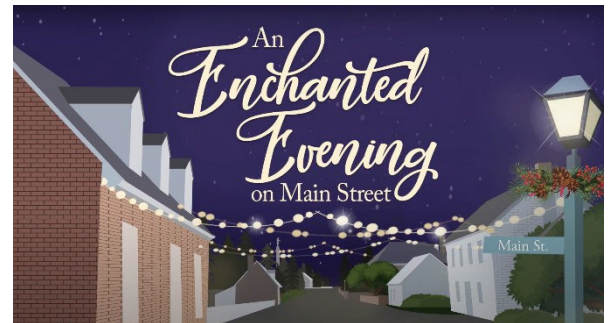

- Kids can pet the animals at the **live nativity scene** in the grassy area in front of York Hall; speak with **Santa** in the York Hall East Room; and make a **Christmas crafts** at On the Hill Gallery.

- **Strolling entertainers** will sing Christmas carols throughout the evening.

**7 to 7:30 p.m.**

- Mobjack Coffee Roasters and Petite Café is hosting a free **Fire Pit Talk** for customers.
