

## REIGN & REBELLION SPECIAL EXHIBITION EXTENDED TO WELCOME SPECIAL APPEARANCE BY ‘OUTLANDER’ AUTHOR DIANA GABALDON SEPTEMBER 16 AT THE AMERICAN REVOLUTION MUSEUM AT YORKTOWN

YORKTOWN, Va., July 17, 2023 – The American Revolution Museum at Yorktown is proud to welcome “Outlander” author Diana Gabaldon for an exclusive appearance and book-signing event at 6 p.m. Saturday, September 16, 2023.

In connection with the Reign & Rebellion special exhibition, now extended through September 19, Gabaldon’s nine-volume historical fiction series capture numerous ties to the Royal Stuarts’ reign and legacy through the American Revolution.

Diana Gabaldon is the author of the award-winning, New York Times best-selling “Outlander” novels, which have sold 50 million copies in 39 languages and 114 countries.

“An Evening with Diana Gabaldon” on September 16 is \$20 per person and will feature a 45-minute presentation by Gabaldon, followed by a two-hour book signing opportunity for ticketed guests.

### ABOUT DIANA GABALDON & “OUTLANDER”

Gabaldon, a scientist with a doctorate in quantitative behavioral ecology, jumped the academic rails in 1991 with the debut of her classic “Outlander” novel. Her adventure has continued with eight more New York Times best-sellers, with the most recent release “Go Tell the Bees That I Am Gone.” STARZ and Sony Pictures Television have created a popular original television series based on the books, also called “Outlander,” filmed in Scotland and presently distributed in more than 187 territories.

A prolific writer, Gabaldon also has written “The Exile,” an “Outlander” graphic novel, a best-selling sub-series of historical mysteries featuring character Lord John Grey, and “The Scottish Prisoner,” featuring both Lord John Grey and Jamie Fraser, plus several novellas.

STARZ and Sony Pictures Television recently premiered its seventh season of the popular “Outlander” television series with an eighth and final season anticipated, along with a prequel show focusing on Jamie Fraser’s parents, Brian and Ellen.
